## Luanda - Massangano – Cambambe - Calulo - Wako Kungo – Gabela - Cachoeiras Falls – Porto Amboim - Luanda

Includes – transport in fully equipped air conditioned 4x4 vehicles (satellite phones, 1<sup>st</sup> aid kits, recovery equipment etc) with English / Portuguese speaking driver guides, accommodation and meals as indicated, all park fees and tolls.

### Day 1: Luanda – Massangano – Cambambe - Calulo

We depart from Luanda at 6:00am and travel towards Dondo. After some 250kms we turn right towards Massangano. Like Luanda, Massangano was also founded by Paulo Dias de Novais in 1582. The fortress at Massangano was built in 1583 and is one of the oldest in Angola. The city was used as a base for the Portuguese during their expeditions to the interior of the country to capture slaves. In the 17<sup>th</sup> century it became the temporary capital of Angola when the Dutch occupied Luanda from 1641 to 1648. Paulo Dias passed away in 1589 and he was laid to rest in Massangano, his tomb is still here.

We then move on passing through Dondo where we can appreciate the Kwanza River which is very broad at this point. Here we start to climb, we then take the Huambo road towards Cambambe Dam where we stop for a snack lunch and a short visit (up to the Dam wall if we can get permission). We then continue south and visit the charming town of Calulo famous for its coffee farms, its fort, views. We will either stay in the town or at Cabuta Farm depending on room availability.

Accommodation: Cabuta Farm or Calulo Ritz or Tia Ka (will depend on availability at time)

### Day 2: Calulo – Cabuta – Quibala – Waku Kungo

After breakfast, (if we stay at Calulo) we move on to visit Cabuta Farm and its fantastic views, then continue south through Quibala the green hilly landscapes typical of Kwanza Sul onto Wako Kungo. We will continue on and up to Quibala and at the end of the day will arrive at Wako Kungo where we will stay at the recently refurbished Ritz. We will visit a church in the beautiful "Angolan breadbasket" that Wako Kungo is famed to be, taking a tour of the town and other local areas of interest.

Accommodation: Ritz Waku Kungo.

Meals included – Breakfast, Snack Lunch and Dinner.

### **Day 3: Wako Kungo - Cachoeiras –Porto Amboim - Luanda**

After breakfast we have a “town tour” and then start our journey north. At Quibala we turn west towards the coast and Gabela. Time permitting we will stop off at CADA an old coffee estate just west of Gabela. Then we will stop off to visit the pretty Cachoeiras Falls and have lunch. We will then move northwards to Porto Amboim and Luanda.
